Excerpt: . of the alimentary canal. The suspensory or falciform ligament extends from the caudal surface of the diaphragm and the abdominal wall, to the surface of the liver, which its line of attachment divides into halves. The round ligament is the thickened free caudal border of the suspensory ligament. It is the remains of a vein which in fetal life joined the offspring to the mother. A third ligament connects the dorsal border of the liver with the diaphragm. The broad ligaments of the uterus are the folds of peritoneum which embrace the uterus, the Fallopian tubes, and the ovaries. The ovarian ligaments are short cords extending from the ends of the uterine cornua to the ovaries. The round ligaments of the uterus pass from the sides of the uterus to the brim of the pelvis.
