As a frequent contributor to The Mentor, Life, and Ladies Home Journal, he sometimes signed his artwork as O Herford. In 1906 he wrote and illustrated the Little Book of Bores (1906). He also wrote short poems like The Chimpanzee and The Hen, as well as writing and illustrating The Rubaiyat of a Persian Kitten (1904), Cynic s Calendar (1917) and Excuse It Please (1930). He also co-authored John Cecil Clay in writing Cupid s Almanac and Guide to Hearticulture for This Year and Next by Clay in 1908.
