




Arkansas County

Located in the heart of the Grand Prairie, Stuttgart, one of two Arkansas County seats, is known as the ?duck and rice capital of the world.? Bayou Meto and several lakes draw waterfowl to the area each fall, and ducks flocking to Stuttgart attract hunters from across the nation. Each November, the community hosts the World Championship Duck Calling Contest.
