The request represents the President s RD priorities; Congress may opt to agree with part or all of the request, or may express different priorities through the appropriations process. In particular, Congress will play a central role in determining the extent to which the federal RD investment can grow in the context of increased pressure on discretionary spending and how available funding will be prioritized and allocated. Low or negative growth in the overall RD investment may require movement of resources across disciplines, programs, or agencies to address priorities. Funding for RD is highly concentrated in a few departments. Under President Obama s FY2013 budget request, seven federal agencies would receive 95.8 of total federal RD funding, with the Department of Defense (50.6) and the Department of Health and Human Services (22.3 , primarily for the National Institutes of Health) accounting for nearly three-fourths of all RD funding. Among the largest changes proposed in the President s request, the RD budget of the Department of Defense would fall by \$1.535 billion (-2.1), while RD funding for the Department of Commerce s National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) would increase by \$1.329 billion. The NIST growth is fueled by increases in funding for its core research laboratories and by the establishment of two new initiatives: \$1 billion for the National Network for Manufacturing Innovation, which seeks to promote the development of manufacturing technologies with broad applications, and \$300 million for a Wireless...
